JERILDERIE RED

BOTANIC NAME

Brachychiton Jerilderie Red

DESCRIPTION

A grafted (dwarf) form hybrid of the very attractive Illawarra flame tree which produces masses of red bell shaped flowers during the summer months. Brachychiton Jerilderie Red is one of a number of new grafted natives becoming increasingly popular in landscape design.

WHY HAS THIS SPECIES BEEN CHOSEN?

We have selected this tree because it is:

- Native.
- Can tolerate long periods of drought, once established.
- Adaptable to wide variety of soil types.
- Fits with the general environment of the street and suburb.
